CoR requires that all parties involved in the road transport supply chain have specific obligations under the law to prevent a breach in the CoR legislation.

Silk Contract Logistics recognises its responsibility for road safety and accepts the obligation to comply with the road safety legislation.

Silk Contract Logistics will do this by:

- Taking all reasonable steps to comply with road transport laws that apply to its operations;
- Always maintaining and promoting safe operations;
- Actively promoting to all appropriate employees and contractors, compliance with road safety laws and CoR legislation;
- Ensuring adequate systems, procedures and processes are in place to meet CoR guidelines;
- Providing CoR training, inductions and education to employees and sub-contractors;
- Communicating with our customers to ensure they understand the need to comply with their CoR obligations when engaging with Silk Contract Logistics.

Disciplines covered by the CoR include, but are not limited to, fatigue management, speeding, packing, scheduling, mass, dimension and load restraint requirements.

Safety is a core value of Silk Contract Logistics and is the responsibility of all employees and contractors with involvement in operations at all levels to demonstrate ongoing commitment to this Policy through personal action and participation.
